**COORDINATION OF WIA TRAINING FUNDS POLICY**

**Policy No. 10**

**PURPOSE:**

To ensure that Workforce Investment Act (WIA) training funds are coordinated with other grant assistance funding.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Workforce Investment Act intends to create a seamless service delivery system for individuals seeking workforce development services by linking the One-Stop partners in the One-Stop delivery system.

**REFERENCES:**

- Title 20 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Sections 662.280, 663.320, and 663.620

**GENERAL POLICY:**

WIA funding for training is limited to participants who:

1. Are unable to obtain grant assistance from other sources to pay the costs of their training; or
2. Require assistance beyond that available under grant assistance from other sources to pay the costs of such training.
3. Program operators must coordinate training funds available and make funding arrangements with One-Stop partners and other entities. Partners or other sources of grants to pay for training costs include, but are not limited to, Welfare-to-Work, Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF), State funded training programs, and Federal Pell Grants. WIA funds should supplement other sources of training grants.
